The Chase Morris Foundation is dedicated to raising awareness of **sudden cardiac arrest** (SCA) in students and saving lives through community education and awareness events, promoting youth heart screenings, awarding student scholarships and donating automated external defibrillators (AEDs) to youth-based organizations.

The Chase Morris Foundation was founded in honor of Chase Morris, who was 16 years old when he collapsed after a day filled with sports activities in Grove, OK, on May 20, 2013. Chase was an avid athlete, playing on the Grove high school tennis team and placing in the state championship a few weeks before. There was no warning. There were no signs. Just a sudden collapse and Chase was gone. Following Chase's death, **The Chase Morris Foundation**, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, was founded to raise awareness of undiagnosed heart issues in student athletes.

Chase was excited to pursue his education at a university level, so the **Play for Chase** scholarship honors his memory by supporting students who desire to pursue their education at a post-secondary education. Additionally, Chase impacted many people with his spirit, his wit and his love of people. This scholarship honors students who make an impact in their community.

The **Play for Chase** scholarship will be awarded to two high school students in the amount of to be determined by the committee who demonstrate academic excellence, school and community participation and leadership potential.

Eligibility

- Graduating senior from Grove Public Schools
- Enrolling in an accredited undergraduate degree program at a two or four-year university
- Preference given to tennis player and/or student athlete, but not mandatory

Requirements

- Completed application
- Copy of high school transcript
- Letter of recommendation from at least one teacher
